CONTROL OF THE GOVERNMENT BY PRIVATE VESTED INTEREST GROUPS

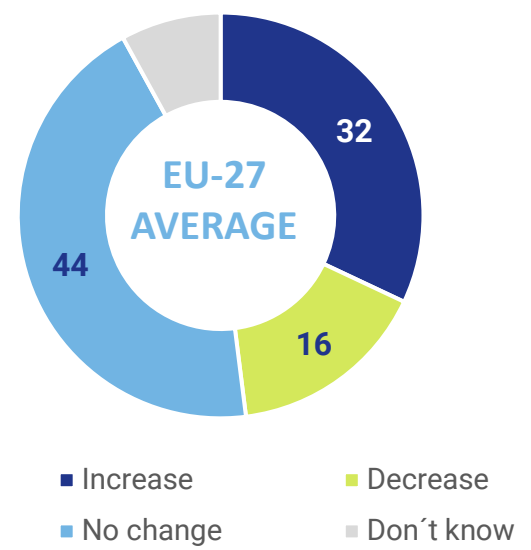
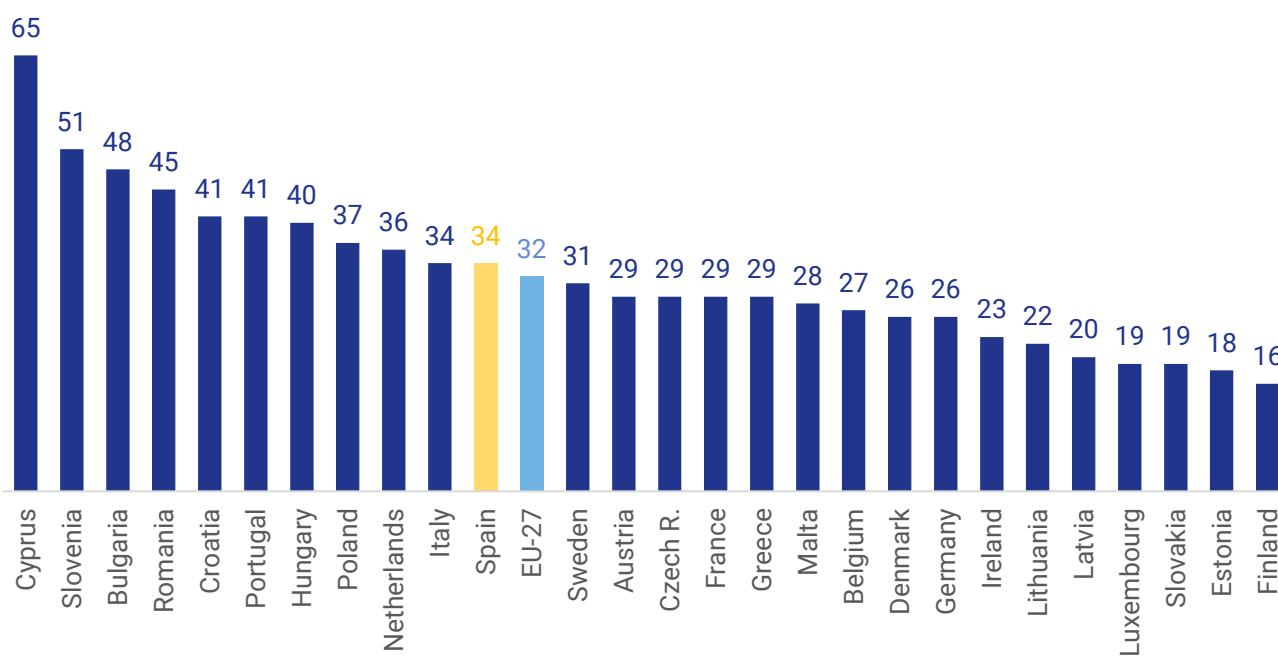

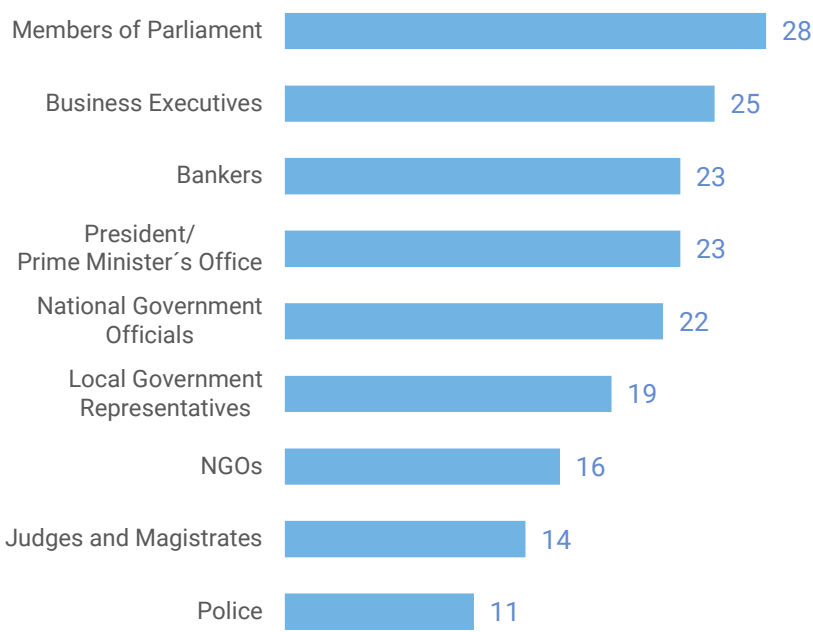
Perception of corruption in the EU-27

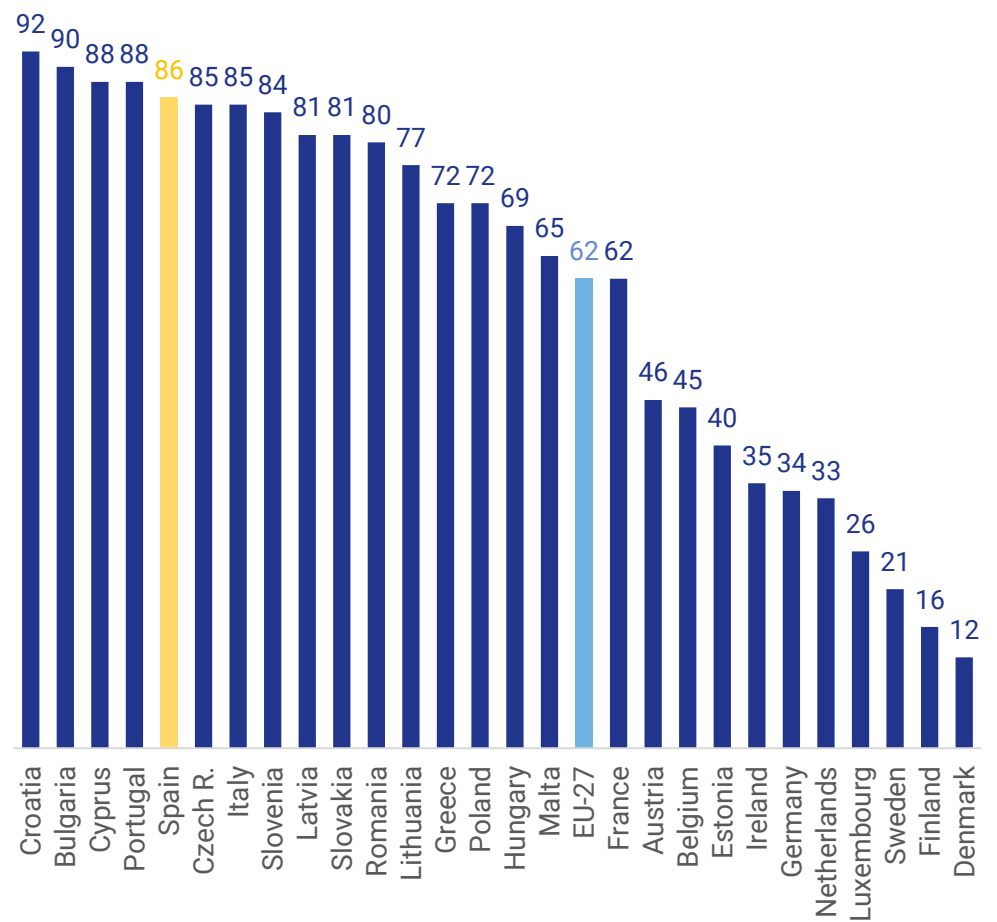
Greater perception of corruption over the past 12 months

% of the population that think that most people act corruptly

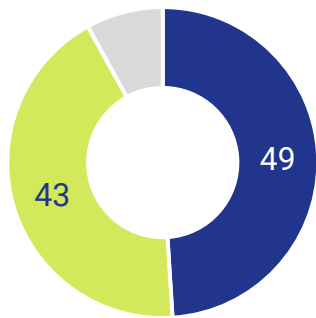

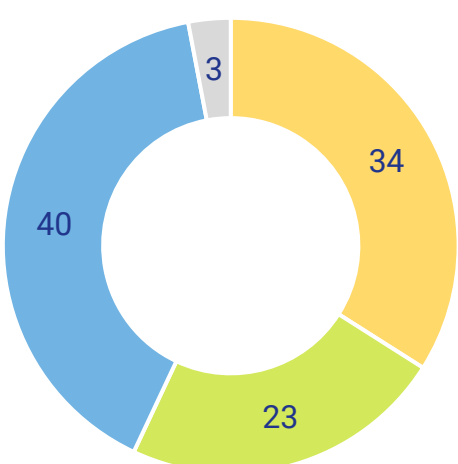

EVOLUTION OF CORRUPTION OVER THE PAST 12 MONTHS

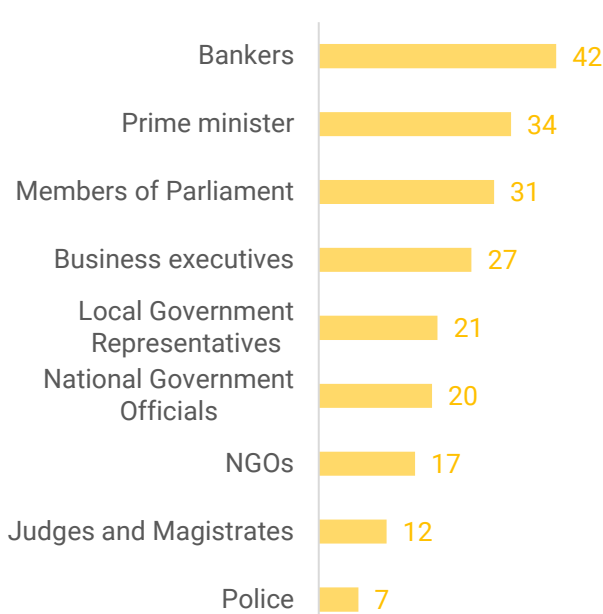
23% of those surveyed in Spain have noticed a decrease in corruption compared to 16% in the EU

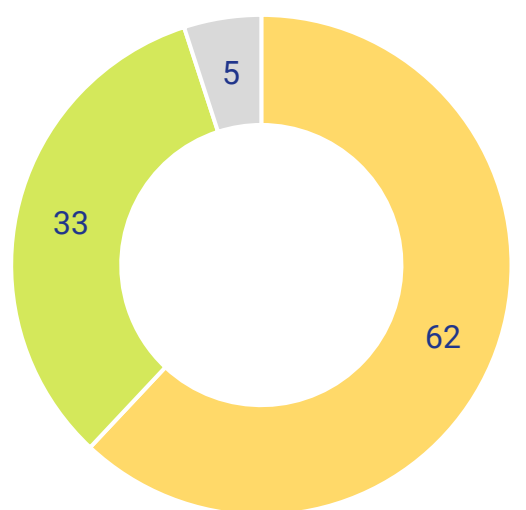
CORRUPTION IN SOME INSTITUTIONS
