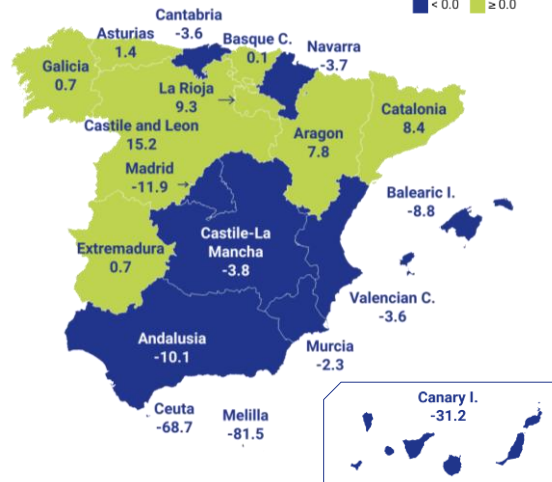

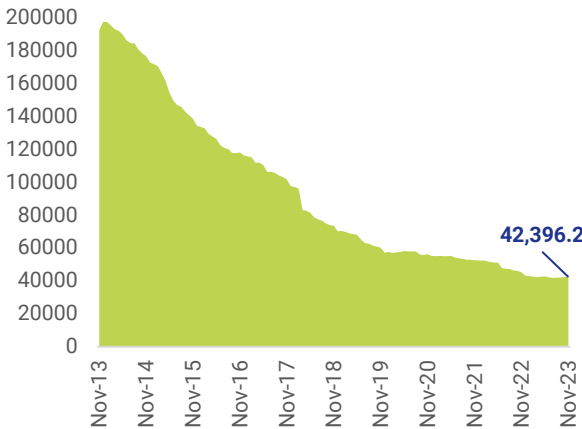

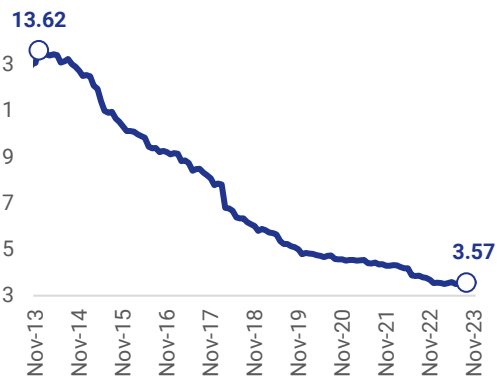

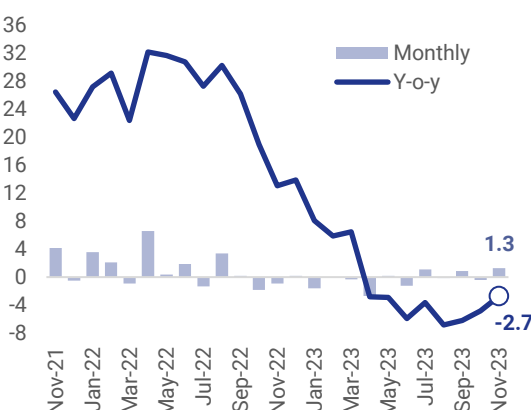

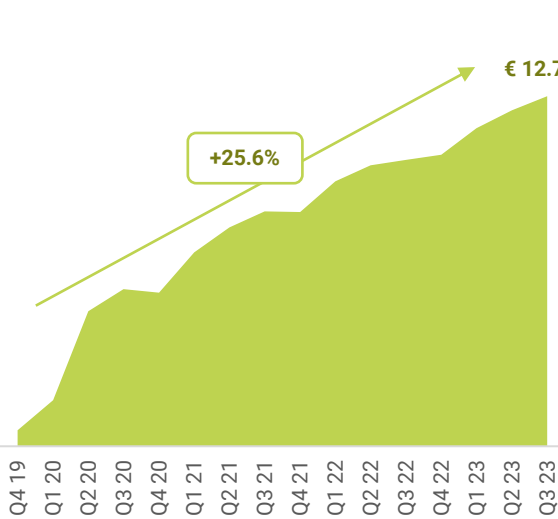

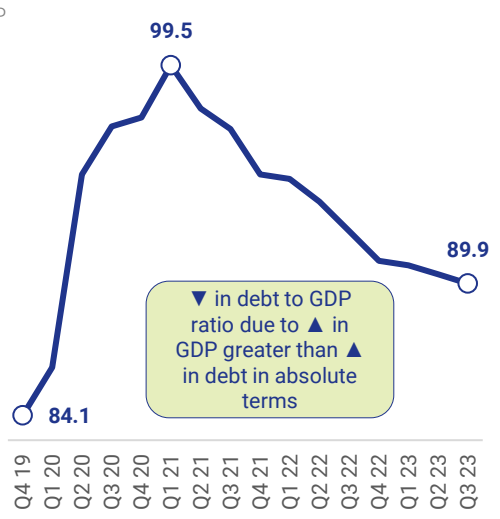

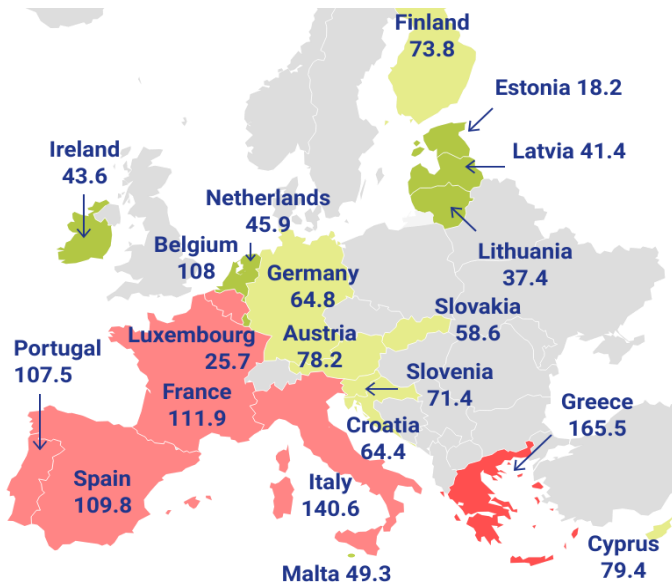

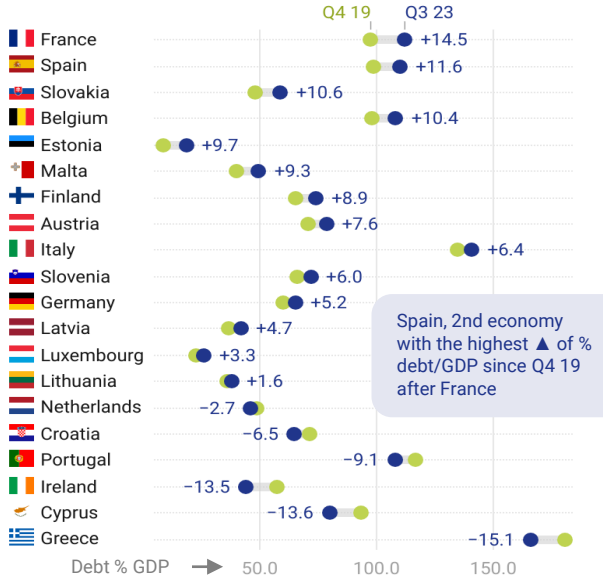


By countries Q3 23

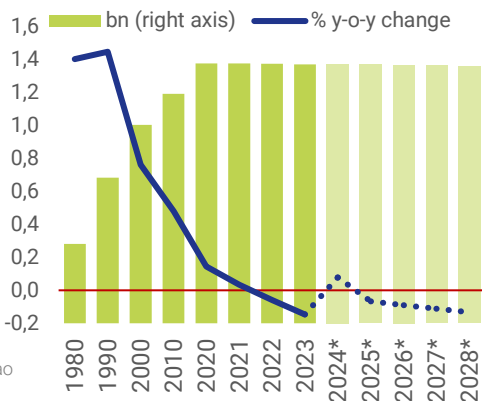
